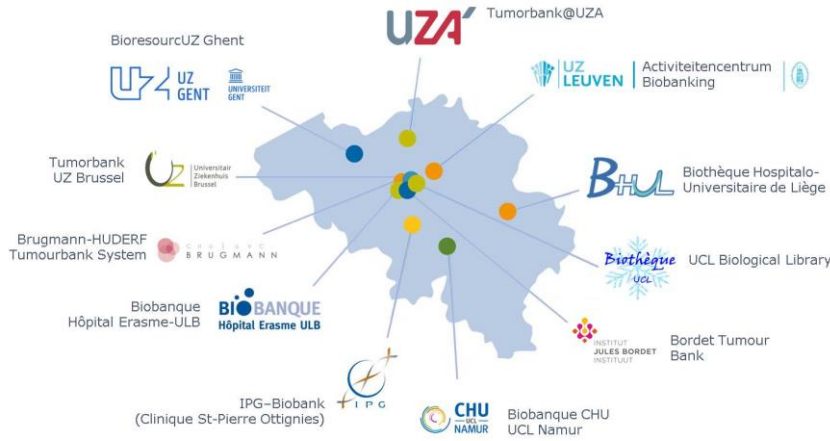


Looking for human tumour samples?



Have a look at the Belgian Virtual Tumourbank - catalogue !



The Belgian Virtual Tumourbank (BVT) project consists of a network of eleven Belgian university hospitals. To facilitate the search for tumour samples scattered among different institutions, one central database collects data from residual material of human tumours. This data is made available to researchers via the Belgian Virtual Tumourbank catalogue (BVTc). The BVTc contains general, patient, medical and technical data.
